

The “Lost” Skit

Pick a person to play each of the three roles:

- 1 – The person who lost the dollar.
- 2 – The first person to enter.
- 3 – The second person to enter.

Here’s the way this skit goes:

Scene: Classroom is a log cabin out in the woods. It’s night time.

1 walks around the classroom looking for something.

After a few seconds:

2 walks in.

2 “What are you doing?” (Make it natural to your language, such as “Whatcha doin’?”)

1 “Looking for my dollar. I lost it.”

2 “I’ll help you find it.”

1 and 2 resume searching.

After a few seconds:

3 walks in.

3 “What are you guys doing?” (Once again, make it natural.)

2 “Helping him/her look for his/her dollar.”

3 “Ok. I’ll help you then.”

1, 2 and 3 resume searching.

After a few seconds:

2 “Where did you lose your dollar? We could look closer to that area.”

1 “Oh, I lost it outside.”

2 and 3 stop looking and look directly at 1.

3 Angrily: “Why are we looking in here then?”

1 “Because the light’s better.”

Wait for laughter. 1, 2 and 3 smile and bow.
